The Rehearsals

- ★ Main Rehearsals for the show will start with the entire cast on Wednesday 5th September 2018. A full schedule will be issued at that time.
- ★ Rehearsals will normally be held on Thursday evenings for the entire company (Principals and Chorus) and there will be an additional rehearsal evening for Principals and Ensemble as required on Wednesdays. There may be a few Sunday rehearsals but these will be kept to a minimum and only at the end when we are running the show. All rehearsals will take place at the Giles Brook School, Holborn Cres, Tattenhoe, Milton Keynes MK4 3GB (unless told otherwise) and will begin promptly at 7.30pm, finishing at 10.00pm.
- ★ To ensure that this show is of the high standard expected of MKAOS, cast members are expected to attend all rehearsals as required. If you do not regularly attend rehearsals, you may be asked to leave the cast.

The Auditions

- ★ The audition panel will include John Dowell [Co-Director], Amy Hansford [Co-Director], Juliet Lennox [Choreographer], Kevin Amies [Producer], Martin Putman [Society President] and an Independent Person [TBA].
- ★ Auditions will be held on **Sunday 15th July 2018** at **Giles Brook School**, **Holborn Cres**, **Tattenhoe**, **Milton Keynes MK4 3GB**. There will be a group movement audition for everyone who wants to be in the show plus singing auditions for the chorus and principal auditions for individual roles.
- ★ If you cannot attend on the day of the auditions, please speak to the Director. You will be asked to submit a recorded audition (on Video/DVD) and we may be able to make arrangements for this if you do not have facilities available yourself.
- ★ EVERYONE must complete and return an audition form to the advertised address by the end of (midnight) on **Friday 6th July**. You will then be notified of the time for your audition(s) by phone or email. You can download an audition form from our website.





- ★ YOUTH MEMBERS <u>must</u> also submit an additional 'Parental Permission' form. Youth Members include anyone still in full time education (up to Year 11) at the time of the final performance. This must be attached to your Audition Form.
- ★ Audition pieces: Audition pieces, including principal dialogue, song lyrics and song backing tracks can be downloaded from our websites: www.mkaos.co.uk or www.dreamsnwishes.co.uk.
- ★ Remember; the auditions are your one chance to show the audition panel what you are capable of, so please learn your song and script so that you make the best possible impression!
- ★ The cast list: this will be posted on our website www.mkaos.co.uk or www.dreamsnwishes.co.uk. Let us know if you don't have access to a computer and we'll make alternative arrangements.

The Show Subscription

- ★ You don't have to pay anything to audition. The Show Subscription will include Membership to the Society for the period of the Show. The Subscription is £20.00 for Youth Membership and £25.00 for Adults.
- ★ All fees must be paid by the end of September at the very latest.
- ★ Scripts will be available to buy. Copies will cost £5.00 each. All principals will require a script.
