



## Glinda Audition Piece 1

(There are two sections to this audition, please prepare both parts. In Part 1, Glinda appears in a prologue before the panto starts and begins to narrate the story)

**Glinda** Hello boys and girls! Now come along it's panto, I said hello boys and girls!

That's lovely. My name is Glinda the Good Witch of the North and oh, do I have a story for you. (Questioning herself,) Do I have a story? Oh yes I have; it's the story of Dorothy Gale from Kansas. She's going to have an adventure, right here in the merry old Land of Oz. Like all good stories it's a

tale of good versus evil and I'll do my best to protect her.

Now you see boys and girls, Dorothy Gale lived with her Auntie Em on a

Glinda No, here in Oz. (LX: raise lights behind gauze) In Munchkinland, to be

precise. And if we hurry there now, we might be in time to see it. Come on

boys and girls, let's away - let's go to Munchkinland!

## Glinda Audition Piece 2

(Part 2 is in Munchkinland. Glinda protects Dorothy when The Wicked Witch Of the West finds out that a house fell on her sister – and that the silver shoes have gone!)

Witch What's going on here?

**Dorothy** (Aside,) I thought you said she was dead...

Glinda Nah, she only looks like it. That's the Wicked Witch of the West. She's the

sister of – you know – your flat mate.

**Witch** Who killed my sister? (*To audience*,) Was it you? Well if it wasn't you, who

did it? You eh? Well little girlie you've done me a favour. I never liked my sister much anyway; a spoilt brat who never ate her broccoli. And with her





out of the way, I can finally get those shoes off her. (Looks around.)

They're gone! Where are they?

**Glinda** (Indicates,) They're Dorothy's now. Here they are and here they'll stay.

**Witch** Give them to me – or I'll turn you into a frog!

Glinda Take no notice, she has no power here. If she had, she would've taken

them by now. Their magic must be very powerful, you keep them on.

Witch Very well, I may not be able to take care of you right here but I'll be back.

And then, not even the power of the magic shoes will save you. (To

audience,) I'll get you lot too, ha ha ha! (Exit.)

**Dorothy** Oh dear, she doesn't seem to like me very much does she?

**Glinda** Well, let's just say; she'll probably unfriend you on Facebook.

**Em** Then we've got to get away, the sooner the better.

**Dorothy** Oh please Glinda, can you help us get back to Kansas?

quite a way from here, are you sure your house doesn't fly?

**Dorothy** Quite sure.
