The Rehearsals

- Main Rehearsals for the show will start with the entire cast on Wednesday 15th September 2021. A full schedule will be issued at that time.
- Rehearsals will normally be held on Thursday evenings for the entire company (Principals and Chorus) and there will be an additional rehearsal evening for Principals and Ensemble as required on Wednesdays. We are starting rehearsals later than normal this year and may need Sunday afternoon rehearsals too. We usually have them for the last month of the rehearsal run and if we need more we will try to keep it to a minimum.
- ★ All rehearsals will take place at the Giles Brook School, Holborn Cres, Tattenhoe, Milton Keynes MK4 3GB (unless told otherwise) and will begin promptly at 7.30pm, finishing at 10.00pm.
- ★ To ensure that this show is of the high standard expected of MKAOS, cast members are expected to attend all rehearsals as required. If you do not regularly attend rehearsals, you may be asked to leave the cast.

Casting

The final show script is usually refined over the 6-8 week period between auditions and rehearsals to suit those who are cast. For example, the dialogue written for traditional male Ugly Sisters would be completely different to that for silly girly stepsisters. The period between the auditions and the start of rehearsals has been cut short this year out of necessity as a result of the pandemic restrictions. Consequently, we don't have the usual luxury of that time for tweaking the script.

Therefore certain roles - those whose dialogue is directly influenced by who plays them - have been precast. Those roles are:- The Fairy Godmother, The Stepmother, Buttons and stepsister Santizia.

The Auditions

- ★ The audition panel will include John Dowell [Co-Director], Amy Hansford [Co-Director], Juliet Lennox [Choreographer], Kevin Amies [Producer], Martin Putman [Society President].
- ★ Auditions will be held on Sunday 12th September 2021 at Giles Brook School, Holborn Cres, Tattenhoe, Milton Keynes MK4 3GB. There will be a group movement audition for





everyone who wants to be in the show plus singing auditions for the chorus and principal auditions for individual roles.

- ★ If you cannot attend on the day of the auditions, please let us know ASAP. You will be asked to submit a video audition.
- ★ EVERYONE <u>must</u> complete and return an audition form to the advertised address by the end of (midnight) on Friday 3rd September 2021. You will then be notified of the time for your audition(s) by phone or email. You can download an audition form from our website.
- ★ Audition pieces: Audition pieces, including principal dialogue, song lyrics and song backing tracks can be downloaded from our websites: <u>www.mkaos.co.uk</u> or <u>www.dreamsnwishes.co.uk</u>.
- ★ Remember; the auditions are your one chance to show the audition panel what you are capable of, so please learn your song and script so that you make the best possible impression!
- ★ The cast list: this will be posted on our website <u>www.mkaos.co.uk</u> or <u>www.dreamsnwishes.co.uk</u>. Let us know if you don't have access to a computer and we'll make alternative arrangements.

The Show Subscription

- ★ You don't have to pay anything to audition. The Show Subscription will include Membership to the Society for the period of the Show. The Subscription is £20.00 for Youth Membership and £25.00 for Adults.
- ★ All fees must be paid by the end of September at the very latest.
- ★ Scripts will be available to buy. Copies will cost £5.00 each. All principals will require a script.

The Other Stuff

If you would prefer not to be on stage but would like to be involved in the production in some other way then there are plenty of areas where we need your help.

★ Marketing and Publicity

With over 5000 tickets to sell, we need to be noticed around Milton Keynes! If you would like to get involved with helping to get our voices heard through MK then please speak to the Show Producer.

★ COVID 19 Procedures

To mitigate risk, we will need everyone involved in this production to be double vaccinated and there will be no persons under 18 years old involved in this show. We will also require you to fully comply with the enhanced procedures that will be in place throughout the rehearsal and production run. This will include the requirement for all cast/crew obtaining a negative Lateral Flow Test (self administered) result prior to attending each rehearsal and performance.
